- Paid vacation employment with practical training and on-site exposure,
- On-going mentorship from our highly experienced staff and full-time employment on graduation.

## Are you eligible to apply?

- Learners must demonstrate academic potential.
- Learners must be South African citizens.
- Preference may be given to historically disadvantaged learners.
- Funding may only be awarded for full time study.
- The learners must demonstrate a high level of passion towards working outdoors and want to contribute and make a difference to the environment.
- The application process is highly competitive and potential applicants must be able to demonstrate both a high degree of motivation and the preparation and ability required to complete their studies.
- Learners who are currently enrolled in Grade 12 are required to attached proof of application made to their University of choice.
- Learners already registered at University will need to provide academic record.



## Approved Fields of Study

Students must be eligible and want to study towards a career in the Environmental and Social Services Industry.

As such the following fields of study will be eligible for bursary support:

- BSc. Environmental Sciences, Geography, Zoology, Soil Science, Aquatic Health, Hydrogeology, Hydrology and Botany.



## Academic Criteria

Only applicants who have obtained the following marks for Grade 12 all year will be considered:

- A minimum of 60% in Mathematics
- A minimum of 60% in English
- A minimum of 60% in Physical Science
